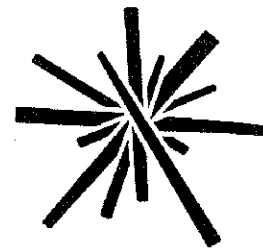

The Camp Fire Sparks After School Club Program is offered by Camp Fire Heart of Iowa in Des Moines, Iowa for children in 5th-8th grade. Our caring professionals provide specific activities for your child to participate each of which is balanced throughout the day or week including:

- **Homework Help.** We set aside time so that each child has time to work on their homework and can get help from one of our associates.
- **Service Learning.** Youth participate in service learning projects based on community needs. They work together to plan and implement through the entire process. Students have the opportunity to earn Camp Fire's Highest Award– the Wo-He-Lo Award.
- **Small groups.** The activities available can be done either in small groups or alone. They may be initiated by the adults with the expectation that all students will work on the activity, or they may be initiated by the children themselves.
- **Large group.** Activities designed for large group participation generally under the leadership of staff based on youth decision.
- **Indoors and outdoors.** As much as possible, and depending on the weather, we strive to balance indoor and outdoor activities.
